Pest of the Month: Ticks Where are they really hiding?

March and April are peak tick season! Experts predict this year's population to be extremely heavy due to ideal tick conditions. With an increase in ticks, you'll have to be extra vigilant on hikes, in parks, and even in your own backyard!

Ticks like to conceal themselves in inconspicuous areas of your property that are easy for them to jump or drop onto a target host.

Below are some secret tick hiding spots you may not have heard of before.

1. Yard features that may retain moisture- We know that ticks thrive in the cool and moist areas of the property. Places like stone walls, bird baths, wells, and more can harbor moisture and provide the perfect place for ticks to lay low.

2. Perimeter of the lawn- This area tends to be the shadiest and typically houses mulch beds and ornamental shrubbery. Ticks thrive in areas with little-to-no direct sunlight, making this portion of the lawn their prime real estate.

3. Bird Feeders- Did you know that birds can carry ticks the same way other land animals can? If you consider this, plus all the other critters (deer, squirrels, etc.) that frequent bird feeders, it's only natural that ticks would be found around them as well.

4. Shady spots- You'll be hard-pressed to find a tick out in direct sunlight. They almost never cross areas like this, as they probably wouldn't survive the journey. Any really shady areas of the yard are where they'll remain.

5. Low-Hanging Branches- This spot shows just how predatory ticks can be. They hang out on low trees & branches so that they can drop onto any unsuspecting animal, pet, or person that happens to be passing by.

Managing Moss

As the spring rolls around and the snow melts away, many lawns may come out of dormancy with an abundance of moss.



Moss is a product of its environment and can grow almost anywhere, but **prefers moist, shady, acidic soil.** Moss thrives in cold temperatures and underneath snow whereas grass does not. However, the grass will soon spring back to life, cover the moss, and you'll forget it was ever there!



The simplest way to cure the spread of moss is to **balance the pH level of the soil with a lime application**. Fertilizing regularly keeps the grass fed and strong, leaving less room for moss. Aerating and overseeding helps break up moss patches while maintaining turf thickness throughout the seasons. In extreme cases, **raking** the moss out and **filling the areas in with grass seed** is the most straightforward option.
