Our 6-service Lawn Maintainer Care program includes fertilization and weed control with each application. Applications are done about every 4-6 weeks.

Lawn Doctor does not apply one-size-fits-all lawn care. Each lawn is unique, with its own needs. Your Maintainer Care Program is specialized based on your lawn's soil composition and specific conditions.

Based on soil testing, we are able to design and suggest the best program to bring your lawn into the right balance for optimum long-term health. Always using the best premium fertilizers, herbicides, and insecticides available to us on the market.

Your experienced lawn technician will continuously monitor the progress, and keep you informed though after service messages about your lawn's progress all season.

WHAT WE USE

- Slow-Release Granular Fertilizer -since it is encapsulated, it provides a steadier supply of nutrients to the soil as it slowly breaks down.
- Weed Control Granular pre-emergent weed control is used and applied to prevent weed seeds from germinating. It is used along with a liquid post-emergent for weeds that are already growing.
- Tip Alert! Liquid Weed Control needs time too soak into the weeds. Avoid watering or mowing for 2-4 hours to allow the product to start moving into the weeds' root systems.
- **Tip Alert!** For best results, fertilizer applications should be watered in 24-48 hours after application.





Early Spring Service 1

Fertilization for spring green-up and root development to increase turf density. Weed control pre-emergent to prevent crabgrass and weed seeds from germinating.



Late Summer Service 4

Fertilization to soothe the lawn into recovery from summer stress and weed control. Continued summer turf inspection and fall planning.



Late Spring Service 2

Fertilization to promote root growth and a greener lawn. Weed control treatment and lawn inspection for disease or insects. Second crabgrass preemergent to prevent application.



Early Fall Service 5

Fertilization for root development and to strengthen grass color for the fall and weed control. Cool weather disease and insect inspection.



Early Summer Service 3

Fertilization to promote growth and post emergent weed control. Turf inspection for the beginning signs of insect pressure or turf disease. *Preventative Grub Applications will begin in July and run through the Late SummerService 4- through the end of August.



Late Fall Service 6

Winterizing fertilization for root development and proper cold season nutrients for winter, promoting a better wake
