FLEA, TICK & SURFACE FEEDING INSECT CONTROL SERVICE BULLETIN

Eliminates ticks, chinch bugs, sod webworm, billbugs, centipedes, fleas, and ants on your lawn for up to 40 days. Effective flea, tick and other surface feeding insect control is a three-step process.

Today we took the first step.

STEP 1

Apply material to control fleas, ticks and other surface feeding insects in the lawn around your home. Water lightly, approximately ten minutes, to activate the material.

Step 2

Thoroughly vacuum the carpeting and furniture inside your home to remove potential flea and tick eggs.

Step 3

Control fleas and ticks on pets. Your veterinarian or pet store can recommend effective shampoos, collars or sprays.

Alone, each step will reduce flea and tick populations. Effective control is achieved by following the three-step process.

All products have been applied in accordance with the label instructions registered with both State and Federal Governments. **We recommend that your family and pets stay off the lawn until the application has been thoroughly watered into the soil and the grass is completely dry.** Today's service was applied or supervised by a State Certified Applicator. This assures you that the treatment meets all label specifications.
