GRUB PREVENTION SERVICE BULLETIN

Today we applied our grub prevention treatment to your lawn. The material used should control this year's generation of grubs. We are using a very effective, yet honey-bee and earthworm friendly grub preventative treatment this year called Acelepryn. One application in the spring provides season-long protection from white grubs, billbugs and turf caterpillars. Acelepryn is a non-neonicotinoid insecticide that is extremely effective against all white grub species (as well as caterpillars) and has no activity against bees, ants, or wasps.

Water the lawn so the material gets into the soil. Grubs live in the top inch or two of soil, so it is very important to water the material into this target zone. Let your sprinklers run for at least 30 minutes to accomplish this.

Do not mow your lawn until the material has been watered in. If this is not possible, make sure that you **DO NOT bag the clippings**. This assures you that all of the material will get down into the soil.

We recommend that your family and pets stay off the lawn until the application has been thoroughly watered into the soil and the grass is completely dry.

All products have been applied in accordance with the label instructions registered with both State and Federal Governments. Today's service was applied by a State Certified Applicator. This assures you that the treatment meets all label specifications.
